During Brezhnev's, "Era of Stagnation," the Soviet Union became politically, economically, and socially backward, and the need for reforms grew increasingly acute. JOINT LEADERSHIP Many high-level communists believed that the Khrushchev Thaw had gone too far and that his politics needed to be reversed. Stagnation became visible in all levels of society: in the economy, in politics, and in culture. FOREIGN POLICY In 1968, Czechoslovakia was going through the Prague Spring. The Brezhnev era, which had begun with high growth, began to stagnate some time in the early-1970s. Kosygin's "radical" reform attempts were halted in 1971 and his second reform was more modest.
