I fell against the edge of the speaker.â€ Guitarist Keith Richards of the Rolling Stones arrives at Marlborough Street Court, London with girlfriend Anita Pallenberg, 27th June 1973. The pair are charged with possession of cannabis.â€ The Stones were in top form on their legendary 1975 Tour of the Americas, and for a good reason: "[It] was fueled by Merck cocaine," Richards wrote in his memoir, referring to the ultrapure pharmaceutically manufactured form of the drug. But even if it was, theyâ€™d never tell you. â€œThatâ€™s not a card, in my opinion, that should be played,â€ says Jagger, who says heâ€™d like to record another Stones album eventually. â€œI know lots of people do play that card, but it nearly always backfires on them.â€

Nor can he be said to have read the spirit of his generation in several important particulars. Believing as he did that "rock and roll can change the world," he missed the point of the civil rights movement, and was capable of writing after the assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. that Dr. King's death "meant little or nothing to the majority of the American people."
