This French imperialist self-concept forms the focus of Alice Conklin's *Mission to Civilize: The Republican Idea of Empire in France and West Africa, 1895-1930*. Conklin, a historian at the University of Rochester, argues persuasively that the zealous republican ideology animating France's Third Republic in the late nineteenth century also defined its West African empire. To develop and support this thesis, Conklin examines official rhetoric and decision making in French West Africa as manifested in the [End Page 488] directives and policy initiatives of the colonial governors-general over a thirty-five-year period. The office of governor-general, the source of most of Conklin's documentation, was a peculiar feature of the French approach to colonial administration. In France, this idea was followed by a campaign to popularize ideas about Africans' lack of civilization through educational and media materials (13-14). Practically, this was carried out in the colonies through increasing infrastructure, public health campaigns, education, and political reform (38-39; 73-74).
