The Deutsches Symphonie-Orchester Berlin (= DSOB) has played under its present name since 1993. However, its musical tradition dates back more than fifty years. It was founded in 1946, as the "RIAS-Symphonie-Orchester", by the radio station of the American sector of Berlin. Ferenc Fricsay was the first principal conductor. He set high standards to follow in both the mainstream repertoire and the music of the twentieth century; his music-making was distinguished by transparency of interpretation, clarity of structure and vividness. After Fricsay's sadly premature death it was the young Lorin Maazel, Op.24 Radio-Symphonie-Orchester, Berlin Vladimir Ashkenazy.
